Student Wellbeing

Over the past few weeks, Toolbox Education have been presenting a Health and Wellbeing program at Templestowe Valley Primary School.

They have worked with some of the Year 4,5&6 students, presented professional learning to staff and provided an information session for parents after school.

The sessions gave students/parents and staff tools to apply from Cognitive Behavioural Therapy (CBT), Dialectical Behavioural Therapy (DBT) and Acceptance and Commitment Therapy (ACT) to their own lives. Sessions covered included Managing Meltdowns, Emotion Literacy and Mind Games.
